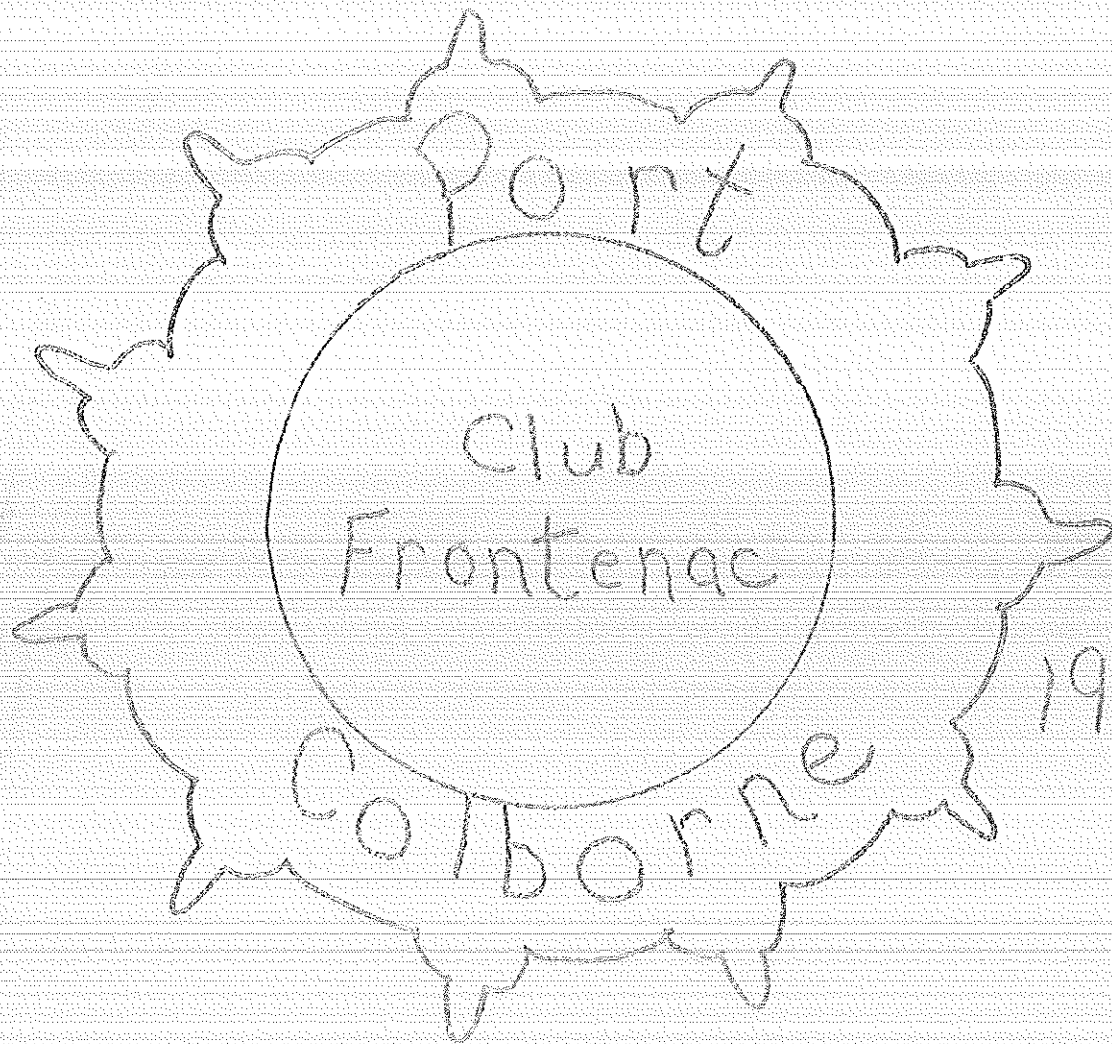

Prior to the 1978-79 season, Club Frontenac received a GRANT. Playing fees were reduced by \$6,00. The grant also covered most of the 1977-78 losses.

Prior to the 1980-81 season, Club Frontenac received another grant. That year, knee pads were bought and sold at approximately half price and we bought 300 shirts at half price. We were able to save about \$500,00. At that time, we had to borrow \$500,00 dollars which was paid back the next 2 years after.

In 1983, we received another grant. We bought equipment. Actually we have bought enough equipment for another 3 years. The grant will cover this year's deficit.

After 7 years of operation, Volleyball shows a loss of \$1 148,69 but this loss is covered by grants received.

Also the Volleyball Banquets have lost around \$900,00 during the past 3 years. This year's loss will be about \$300. These losses are not reflected in the volleyball financial statements because they are covered by our Hockey Banquets.

P.S. For the 1984-85 season playing fees have been raised to \$28,00 which is an increase of \$3,00 over the last year for some girls and \$8,00 for others.

Reasons:

- a) No grant money coming
- b) We are going to 7 players per team, which means a lost of \$20,00 per team in revenues and this means \$240,00 for a 12 team League.
- c) We are using referees from the Association which means an increase of \$3,00 per game. This means a total increase of about \$400 for the year.

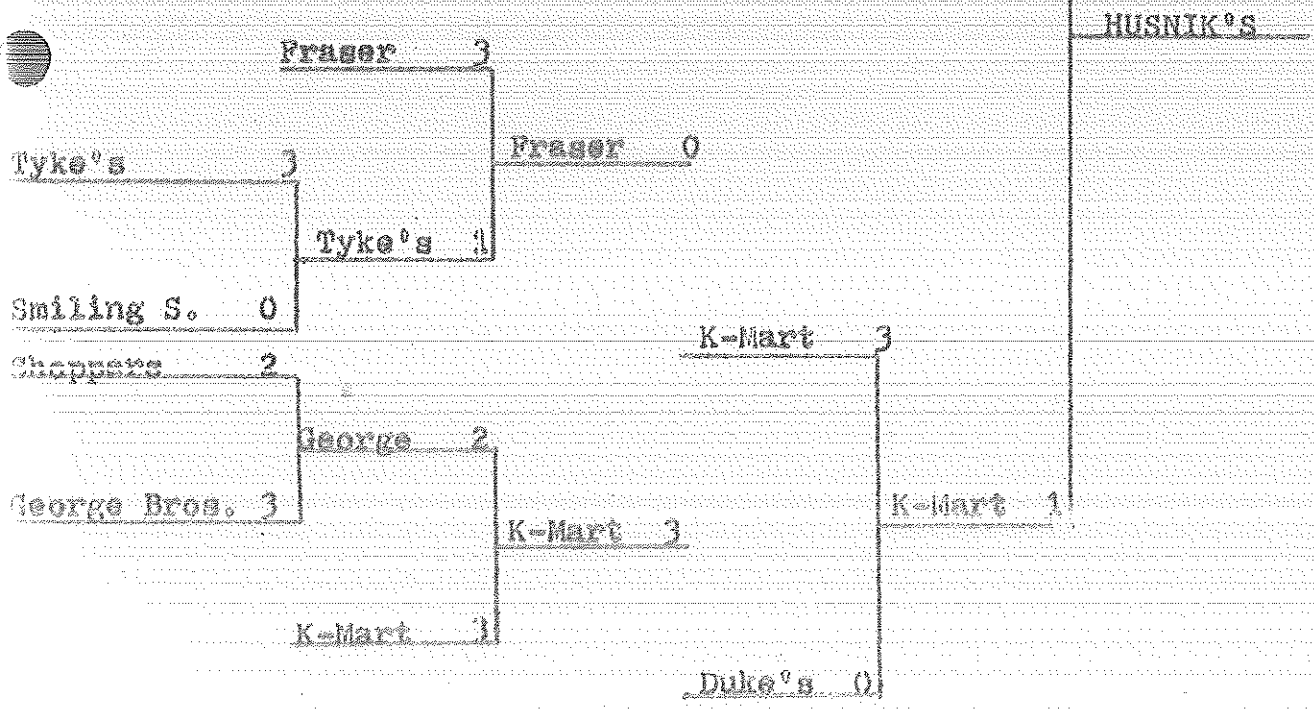
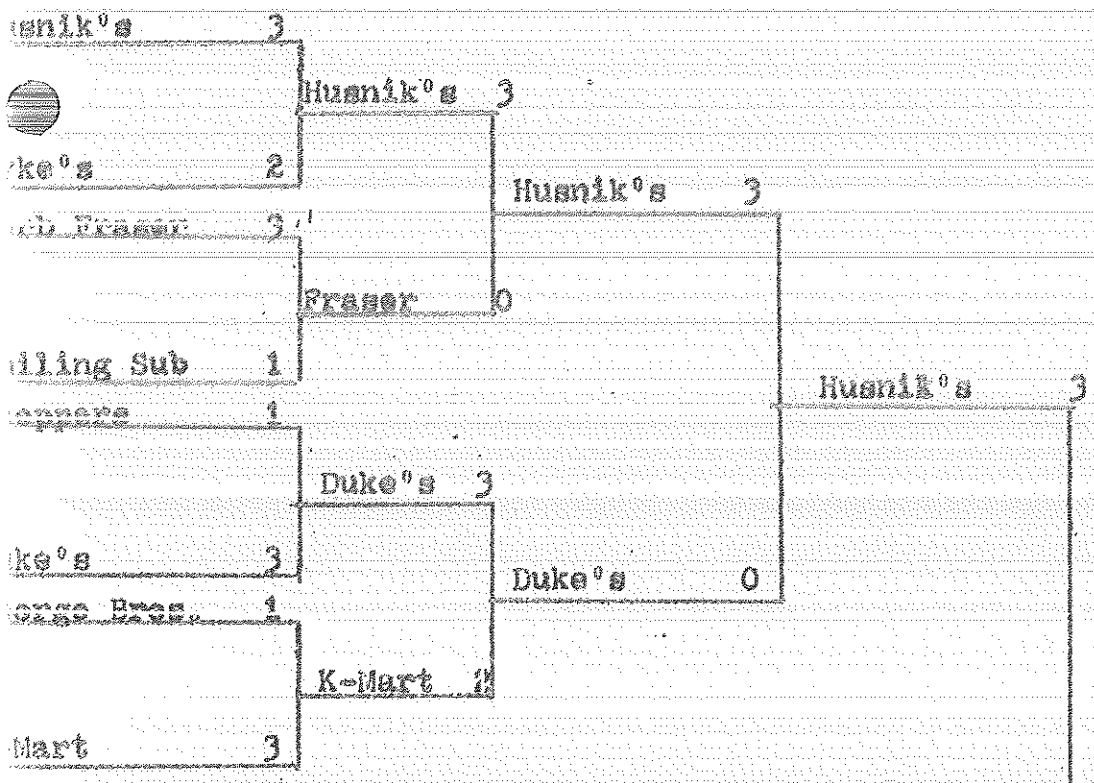
